

On **January 19th**13 of us braved the weather



before the snowstorm and hiked 4 miles at Lenape Park, 130 Kenilworth Blvd, Cranford, NJ along the Rahway River. It took us about 2 hours, and it was a nice walk along the paved trails all the way out to Michigan Ave in Kenilworth at Galloping Hill and then back.

On **February 16th**, we will be hiking or strolling along the Middlesex Greenway, rails to trails in Metuchen. This is fully paved and has a gentle grade over some of the roads. The trail head with plenty of parking is at 685 Middlesex Ave, Metuchen. This is a 7.3-mile out-and-back trail. Generally considered an easy route, it takes an average of 2 h 10 min to complete. This is a popular trail for road biking, running, and walking, but you can still enjoy some solitude during quieter times of day. The trail is open year-round and is beautiful to visit anytime. Dogs are welcome but must be on a leash. The Middlesex Greenway, once part of the Lehigh Valley Railroad, is a popular 3.5-mile paved path. This is a well-designed trail and a pretty ride. There are eight interpretive signs along the trail. www.alltrails. com/explore/trail/us/new-jersey/middlesex-greenway

On **March 16th** we will be hiking at Hartshorne Woods Park along the Grand Tour Trail which is a 5.0-mile loop near Atlantic Highlands, New Jersey. Generally considered a moderately challenging route, it takes an average of 1 h 59 min to complete. www.alltrails.com/explore/trail/us/new-jersey/hartshorne-woods-grand-tour-trail

On **April 6th**, we will be hiking at Cheese-quake State Park.



If you are over 75 years old you will need a doctor's script to donate. Many doctors will give their patients a script stating their ability to donate telephonically. Please donate if you are able.



LANDSCAPE ARTIST

Albert Bierstadt was born in Solingen, Germany in 1830. When Bierstadt was two years old his family moved to New Bedford, Massachusetts where his father found work as a cooper, or barrel maker. From an early age, Albert made crayon sketches and found his life work. In 1853,

Bierstadt returned to Germany hoping to study with a distant relative at the Dusseldorf School of Artists. Unexpectedly, his relative, Johann Hasenclever died. Coming to his aid were Emanuel Leutze and Worthington Whittredge, American mentors. After studying three years with the painters, Bierstadt joined Whittredge on an extended sketching tour of Germany, Switzerland, and Italy. When he returned to New Bedford in 1857, he was a technically skilled painter who gave art lessons and had exhibitions of his artwork. He soon joined a survey group traveling westward to sketch mountain formations. After a short return to New Bedford, Bierstadt settled in New York City and began exhibiting some western paintings which were received very favorably. The most important of these paintings, The Rocky Mountains, Lander's Peak, is in the Metropolitan Museum in New York. After another trip to the Pacific Coast, Bierstadt spent seven weeks in Yosemite Valley.

Studies from this trip gave him material for his grand, detailed paintings which insured his reputation as America's Landscape Artist. Later tours of Europe, Nassau, and Canada gave the artist a variety of colorful, majestic settings for his more than 500 paintings. Among Bierstadt's many honors include the naming of a mountain in Colorado, Mount Bierstadt, and a 1998 set of commemorative stamps entitled "Four Centuries of American Art", one of which featured Albert Bierstadt's The Last of the Buffalo. Albert Bierstadt died in 1902 in New York City a prominent member of the Hudson River School of American landscape artists.


