- **7. Fall Clean-Up** (put away tables, clean outdoor bar and kitchen, leaf and sticky ball removal, show up at 8AM) *-sign-in book.*
- **8.** Entertainment and Decorating Committees (meet first Thursday of every month at 6:30 PM in the main dining room) *there is a sign-in book.*
- **9. Additionally,** if you have a talent or skill, you are willing to donate your time performing, this too can count towards your volunteer hours.




RHEINISCHER SÄNGERBUND



Wer wird der nächste Fußball Europameister?

Die UEFA Europameisterschaften 2024

□ußball ist eine der beliebtesten Sportarten in Deutschland. Daher blicken viele Fußballanhänger mit Spannung auf das 17. UEFA Europameisterschafts Turnier. Bald treffen sich die Nationalmannschaften aus 24 UEFA-Mitgliedsstaaten in Deutschland, um für die Trophäe des UEFA EURO 2024 Turniers und den Titel als Fußball Europameister zu kämpfen. Unter ihnen ist Italien, der aktuelle Europameister. Dennoch gibt es keinen klaren Favoriten für dieses Turnier, es nehmen zu viele hervorragende Teams teil. Vielleicht wird die deutsche Mannschaft, nachdem sie 1972, 1980 und 1996 schon dreimal Europameister war, nun diesen Titel zum ersten Mal im 21. Jahrhundert gewinnen. Nach 1988 ist es bereits das zweite Mal, dass Deutschland alleiniger Gastgeber des UEFA-Europameisterschaft Turniers ist. Als Austragungsort der geplanten Fußballspiele wurden Stadien in 10 Städten ausgewählt. Von Hamburg als nördlichster Stadt bis nach München im Süden und 8 weiteren Städten dazwischen, nämlich Berlin, Köln, Dortmund, Düsseldorf, Frankfurt, Gelsenkirchen, Leipzig und Stuttgart. Während dieses Wettbewerbs werden die Mannschaften und Fans viel durch Deutschland reisen müssen, glücklicherweise bieten die öffentlichen Verkehrsmittel Sondertarife für Ticketinhaber der Fußballspiele an. Insgesamt 53 europäische Nationalmannschaften mussten Vorgualifikationsspiele absolvieren, um am UEFA EURO 2024 teilnehmen zu können. Letztendlich werden 24 erfolgreiche Mannschaften nach Deutschland reisen. Insgesamt sind 51 Spiele nötig, um den nächsten Europameister zu ermitteln. Das Turnier ist in eine Gruppen- und eine K.o.-Phase gegliedert. Für die Gruppenphase werden die 24 Mannschaften in 6 Gruppen zu je 4 Teams aufgeteilt. Alle Teams einer Gruppe spielen gegeneinander. Die beiden bestplatzierten Teams aus jeder Gruppe und

Who will be the next European Soccer Champion?

The 2024 UEFA European Championship

Soccer is one of the most popular sports in Germany. Therefore, many soccer fans are looking forward with excitement to the 17th UEFA EURO tournament. Soon the teams from 24 UEFA member states will meet in Germany to compete for the UEFA EURO 2024 trophy and the title as the European national soccer champion. Amongst them is Italy, the current champion. Yet, there is no clear favorite for this tournament, too many excellent teams are participating. Maybe the German team, after having won the European championship 3 times in 1972, 1980 and, 1996 will win it for the first time in the 21st century. This is the 2nd time after 1988 that Germany is the single host for the UEFA Euro tournament. As venues for the planned soccer matches, stadiums in 10 cities have



to Munich in the south and 8 more cities in between i.e. Berlin, Cologne, Dortmund, Düsseldorf, Frankfurt, Gelsenkirchen, Leipzig, and Stuttgart. During this competition the teams and fans will travel quite bit around Germany, luckily public transportation will offer special fares for ticket holders to the soccer games. A total of 53 European national teams had to go through pre-qualification games for an opportunity to compete in this event. Finally, 24 successful teams will be travelling to Germany. It will take a total of 51 matches to determine the next European champion. The tournament is structured in a group and a knockout phase. For the group phase, 24 teams are divided into 6 groups of 4 teams each. All teams in a group will play against each other. The two top ranked teams from each ground and the four highest ranked 3rd place teams will move on to the "Round of 16", the first knockout round. After two more knockout rounds, the last two undefeated teams will meet on 14 July 2024 in the Berlin stadium to fight in the final match for the European championship. The 6 initial groups are composed of the following teams -

Group A: Germany, Scotland, Hungary, Switzerland

Group B: Spain, Croatia, Italy, Albania

Group C: Slovenia, Denmark, Serbia, England

Group D: Poland, Netherlands, Austria, France

Group E: Belgium, Slovakia, Romania, Ukraine

Group F: Türkiye, Georgia, Portugal, Czechia

For the UEFA EURO 2024 opening match the German and Scottish teams will meet on **June 14** in Munich. The match is set to start at 9pm CET (3pm EST). For the soccer fans in this country, the Fox and Fox Sport network will show 46 out of all 51 games. To watch all 51 games, fans will need a subscription to the FUBO streaming service. However, for other ways to watch selected games for free, I suggest an internet search. And should the German team make it to the finals, how about a public viewing of the match at the DC?

JAWED KARIM - YOUTUBE

Jawed Karim was born in 1979 in Merseburg, East Germany to a Bangladeshi



father, who became a researcher for 3M and a German mother, who is a biochemistry scientist at the University of Minnesota. In the 1980's, the family crossed the border and settled in Neuss, West Germany. Continuing westward, the family came to Saint Paul, Minnesota in 1992 where Jawed, fluent in English, Bengali, and German, graduated high school. Karim next enrolled in the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign majoring in software engineering. While at the university, he served an internship at Silicon Graphics where he worked on 3D voxel data management for large data sets, including the National Library of Medicine's Visible Human Project which detailed three-dimensional representations of normal male and female human bodies. Karim left college early to work for PayPal and in 2002 he met Chad Hurley and Steve Chen. Together, in 2005 they founded the video-sharing website YouTube. Karim starred in the first YouTube website video called Meet Me at the Zoo. With the success of YouTube, Karim stepped back from active work to become an advisor and finished his education with a degree from the University of Illinois, and an MS degree from Stanford University. When YouTube was acquired by Google in


