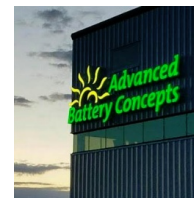

Shared from JAMA

This information is being shared to make you aware of the scam to local manufacturers.

I just received the following from a JAMA member in the Tecumseh area:

We received your message from regarding scrap scammers back in May. Unfortunately it was too late for us as we had provided some scrap metals a day or so prior. The group at that time was very convincing using names of senior staff that were with us for many years. They are making rounds again and visited our facility twice today with the same vehicle and same people. If this is still believed to be a scam I am letting you know so JAMA can pass this information along quickly to others who may be targeted.

Today before lunch three men and two boys came into the front lobby wanting to give [our company] a Certificate of Appreciation in continuing support to Seven Nations Native Youth Program 2018 for our donation of scrap metals to help their youth programs. The group was represented by Billy Red Cloud. Mr. Red Cloud said he had been here once before about 5 years ago, dropped a name [and said he was] given a tour by...the Plant Manager. We believe they were wanting another donation of

scrap metal.

We've also had past reports of them claiming to be OmniSource employees. If they do visit your company and claim to be employees of OmniSource, please report their visit to Dan McDonald at 517.817.2794 or dan.mcdonald@omnisource.com.

Please do NOT let these guys into areas of your building where they can take stock of your inventory or other valuables. With warmer temperatures, many companies open their overhead doors to provide airflow...be aware that this can be an inviting way in for these scrap scammers.

Last but not least, please share this info with ALL of your employees or, at least, make sure that your employees follow a strict policy related to visitors. All it takes is one guy or gal on the shop floor to believe that these guys have permission to be inside your building.
