Saginaw County - CTE - Career Technical Education

Career Technical Education (CTE) provides students with the academic and technical skills, along with the knowledge and training, necessary to succeed in future careers and to become lifelong learners. In total, about 12.5 million high school and college students are enrolled in CTE across the nation. (source)

On Tuesday, November 6, 2018 Saginaw County residents get to decide on a 1.0 mill, 10-year Career and Technical Education millage request. Funds generated by this millage will be used to strengthen and improve existing programs like Automotive Collision Repair/Refinishing, Culinary Arts, Health Occupations, Criminal Justice, Information Technology, and others. Additionally, it will offset enrollment funds for all Saginaw County school districts, provide relief for ever-increasing transportation costs, help purchase new equipment, curriculum materials, and licenses, as well as create new career paths.

New CTE courses offered include:

- Insurance Leadership Academy at Frankenmuth Insurance Agency
- Emergency Medical Technician training through Medical Mobile Response
- Heavy equipment technician training through AIS Equipment of Bridgeport
- Dual enrollment program for Computer Numerical Control
- (CNC) Machining with Delta College, and
- Addition of Cybersecurity programming

Michigan predicts more than 811,000 high-demand, high-wage career openings to fill through 2024 in fields like information technology and computer science, healthcare, manufacturing, and other business and Professional Trades careers. Careers are expected to have an average salary of \$60,532. (source)
