The Sound of Hammers: 755 W Sedona Ridge Place



Construction has begun on a vacant lot on Sedona Ridge. The home will be offered for sale in early 2022. Thank you Michael Theis for the photo!

The formally vacant lot at 755 W. Sedona Ridge Place is now a flurry of activity with hammers flying and walls being erected. The .65 acre property has been vacant since Sunridge Estates II came into development. The property is primarily owned by a trust. Additional information is available on the Pima County Geographic Information System.

Kachina Custom Homes is the builder and construction will take four or five months. When complete, the home

will be approximately 2,800 sq. ft. The builder may offer the home for sale as early as January, prior to the home being completed. The price is still being determined as the pandemic has caused materials to become more expensive and in short supply. The market price is expected to be \$800,000+.

The house is placed on the backside of the lot as there is a broad arroyo bordering Sedona Ridge Place and running down the west side of the lot.

With this lot now under construction, there are four remaining vacant lots within the Sunridge Estates II subdivision. Two of the lots are located on Sedona Ridge Place at the cul de sac. Another lot is at 625 W. Kachina Ridge Place. While there are no immediate plans to build on these lots, only time will tell when they too may be developed.

The fourth lot is at 12457 N. Piping Rock Road. It currently has a For Sale sign on it and is being offered for \$158,000 (this property was last sold on July 10, 2020 for \$85,000). The .46 acre parcel has difficult terrain to build on, so it is being offered complete with building plans for a 2,000 sq. ft. home by the current owners. *Written by: Michael Theis*

Homemade Tortilla Soup Recipe

HOMEMADE TORTILLA SOUP

Ingredients: • 2 TBL olive oil

- 1 cup sweet onion chopped (Vidalia or yellow onion)
- 1 jalapeno chopped (remove seeds before chopping)
- 4 garlic cloves, minced
- 32 oz low sodium chicken broth
- 2 14.5 oz cans of diced tomatoes (keep the juice)
- 1 15 oz can of black beans (drained and rinsed)
- 2 cups shredded cooked chicken (I use the rotisserie chicken)
- 1 package frozen corn
- 1 TBL lime juice
- 2 TBL chili powder
- 2 tsp cumin
- 2 tsp salt
- 1 tsp pepper
- 1 tsp smoked paprika
- 1/4 tsp cayenne pepper

Optional ingredients for toppings:

- Fresh cilantro
- Avocado
- Shredded cheese
- Sour cream
- Tortilla chips
- Making the soup:
- In a large pot, heat the olive oil and add onion and jalapeno and saute for 5 min.
- Add garlic and saute for another 1-2 min.
- Add the rest of the ingredients and simmer for 30 min.
- Taste and add more seasonings if you wish.

Enjoy just as it is or add any of the additional topping ingredients.
