1. ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1. For safety reasons, participants must complete a free Learn to Sail Part 1 at sailboatinstructor.com and present a certificate of completion up to check in (can show your phone). This Part 1 course is a short 30-minute course. A certificate of completion will be emailed to you upon completion or you can login to access your certificate. This is your ticket to a free sailboat ride. You can just show us your certificate on your phone.
- 1.2. Adults (18+) are welcome and must complete a registration form and sign a waiver at check-in.
- 1.3. Life jackets will be provided and must be worn at all times in dock and boat
- 1.4. Guests participate in free rides entirely at their own risk.

2. SCHEDULE

Free sailboat rides (approx 30 minutes) will be offered on Flying Scot sailboats on Saturday Sep 13th at 4:00pm on a first-come-first-served basis. We will only take people out when the winds are 5-12mph, so guest riders are encouraged to watch the weather and set expectations accordingly.
