- The Sparks Planning Commission is holding a **public meeting AND VOTE** regarding the proposed development of **158 new homes** and changes to the **Master Plan Handbook for the Foothills**.

The impact of this project will extend far beyond the proposed construction site. Increased traffic, construction noise, disruption, and changes to the character of our neighborhoods will be felt throughout the community. **More importantly, if the developer is allowed to rewrite one Handbook today, what will stop them from doing the same to the Wingfield Handbook in September?**

Now is the time to stand together. A strong turnout sends a powerful message that our community values the character, stability, and protections that have shaped our neighborhoods for years. This is our opportunity to show decision-makers that residents are paying attention, engaged, and committed to preserving the integrity of our community.
