**WHAT'S NEW**

- **DEVELOPER PUBLIC MEETINGS**

We want to thank everyone who was able to attend the developer's required meetings on Wednesday evening. Many people from both The Foothills at Wingfield and Wingfield Springs expressed concerns and asked specific questions about this project and how it will impact the community including roads, water, environment and schools. Unfortunately, the developers were unable to provide definitive plans or answers to our questions with regards to the project, repeatedly stating that it is still "in the beginning stages."
