- The Sparks Planning commission is holding a **public meeting AND VOTE** regarding the proposed development of **158 new homes** and changes to the **Master Plan Handbook for the Foothills**.

 - **Time:** 6:00 PM
 - **Location:** Washoe County Commissioner's Office - 1001 E. 9th St., Reno
 - ***The meeting has been moved to a larger venue in anticipation of strong community turnout.***

PLEASE NOTE. You might think, “Well, I don’t live in the Foothills” or “I don’t live near the streets where they want to build”. From the beginning, we have said this is not a golf course issue, it’s a Community Issue! We will all be affected by the construction, noise, traffic and disruption to our neighborhoods. If the Developer is permitted to change one Handbook, what is to stop them from succeeding with the Wingfield one in September? (That is when we hear that meeting will take place).
