When you receive the developer's notice regarding the planned meeting on **May 13, do not discard it**. Be sure to **keep both the notice and the envelope**, as the envelope shows the official mailing date. The notice is required to be mailed **at least 10 days prior to the meeting**.

If you:

- Do **not** receive a notice, or
- Receive one that is **postmarked less than 10 days before May 13**, please contact the Wingfield Springs group immediately at **Wingfieldspg@gmail.com**.

Your attention to this is important—thank you for helping to ensure proper notification procedures are followed.
