From October 29 to December 11, 2026

The Honeycomb Show III (the "Show"), produced by The Pollinator Art Space (a dba of Sabre Esler Fine Art LLC, "TPAS") located at 1200 Foster Street, NW, Studio 109, Atlanta, GA 30318, gives artists in our community the opportunity to sell smaller artworks over the holidays. The Show also allows emerging and established collectors alike to acquire original artworks at an accessible price point – perfect for giving, too.

We would love to see what you're currently working on!

If interested in participating, please email the completed application form below to thepollinatorartspace@gmail.com, along with 3-5 jpeg photos that are *representative* of the work that you would like to display at the Show. The photos of the works you send do not have to be the actual works included in the show but should give TPAS a good idea of what to expect. We want to give you enough time to generate new work specifically for the show, if needed! The attached Inventory of Work will be needed for accepted work at the time of drop off.

The parameters of the Show include:

- Cost - Once accepted and you drop off your work, you will pay a flat \$35 fee to @sabre-esler to cover the costs of the show. No other commission or fee will be due.
- Work Size – To be accepted, work must be:
 - 2D Maximum Size: 12"x 12" including frame. Please plan to frame your work for this show unless it is on canvas or panel.
 - 3D Maximum Size: no larger than 12"x 12" x 12"
 - Work does not have to be the max size; a variety of sizes, up to the max sizes above, is appreciated.

Type of work accepted - All ORIGINAL works are accepted. We do not take giclee prints. All works on paper or hand pulled prints are acceptable. Work will need to be ready to hang. No saw tooth hangers. When submitting photos, please submit high quality photos of the work in good lighting. 300 DPI no larger than 1MB.

- Number of Pieces – We will be accepting up to 5 pieces from each accepted artist; however, we will work with artists on an individual basis for smaller items and varied exhibition arrangements.
- Price Range - Preferred price range: \$75 - \$300 retail. Again, we will work with artists on an individual basis for smaller items and varied exhibition arrangements.
- "For Sale" Only - All work is to be for sale.
- Honeycomb Postcard Art Wall - We are also creating a "Honeycomb Show" postcard art wall. Along with the delivery of your work, please provide one 4 x 6 paper (Yes, it has to be this size.) We will use these pieces, one from each artist, to create a "honeycomb" of postcard art that will be for sale. All proceeds of the Honeycomb postcard art will go to The Pollinator Art Space. All postcards will be for sale for \$20. These pieces will hang during the entire Honeycomb Show.

- Notification of Acceptance: October 2, 2026
- Artwork Drop-off: October 24 or October 26, 2026 11-3pm
- Exhibition Dates: October 29, 2025 – December 11, 2026
- Opening Reception #1: Thursday, October 29, 5-9pm
- Opening Reception #2: Sunday, October 29, 11-3pm
- Open Studio with Goat Farm December TBD
- Pick up unsold artwork December 11, 2026 after close.
