



NLIA Water Quality Committee Report May 2026

1. Aeration system maintenance has been conducted by Aqualink
 - a. 9 diffusers have been pulled up and cleaned
 - b. 3 remain to be completed
 - c. 13th diffuser from 2025 still to be located and replaced
 - d. Continued pressing of Aqualink on this matter is on-going. Ultimately, may require NLIA physical engagement/work to bring to conclusion.
2. The 1st Biologic treatment was completed 5/13/26.
3. Committee members and volunteers will be cleaning up the compressor shed and completing some required maintenance in June. Will advise of date if anyone is interested in helping.
 - a. General cleanup
 - b. Replacement of rotted stair treads
 - c. Replace damaged sound attenuation
4. In coordination with Membership and Fundraising have had contact/conversation with Grant Writing /procurement firm. At current time, no viable “high probability” of success grants to pursue.
5. A proposal has been provided by Aqualink for waterlilies and submerged aquatic vegetation – per unit price is \$495.00 per treatment per property
 - a. Committee has some reservations regarding this pricing
6. Current strategic vision remains to stay the course with Aqualink, predicated upon similar results to 2025 and conclusion on the aeration system maintenance. We will continue to vet scope and pricing on a continual/annual basis.
