# LORD, PLEASE HAVE MY SIX

**In Exodus 14 we find the first real encounter where the Children of Israel need God to help them and have their six “back”**

**V10-14 – As the Egyptians approach the people panic**

**V15-18 – God tells Moses “Don’t worry, I’ve got your six “back” – what a comfort Moses received**

**V19-20 – The angel of God and the pillar go to get their six “back”**

**V21-22 – While the Lord has their six “back” they walk through on dry ground**

# LORD, PLEASE HAVE MY SIX

In Psalm 34 David gives praise and speaks of how the Lord has His people's six "back"

V1-3 – Praise the Lord always!

V4 – He had my six "back" for ALL my Fears

V5 – Because we know who has our six "back"

V6 – Not some but ALL my Troubles

V7 "Fear" - Hebrew word – "yare" - meaning - To Revere, to see as awesome, to stand in awe

V8-11 – With a true relationship with the Lord He will provide for your needs

V15-20 – The Lord has the six "back" of the righteous
