




VISION STATEMENT

- Acts 9:1-2 Saul was in the very process of sinful behavior and actions
- Acts 9:3-6 He came into contact with the Lord and his life was forever changed

Gideon was afraid but ended up with a testimony Judges 6:1 – The people sinned and God punished them

Judges 6:7-10 — God reminds them of what He had done for them and what they did in return

Judges 6:14-15 – The call to deliver the people is

given but Gideon is afraid

<u>Judges 6:20-22</u> — God gives Gideon a strong sign of His presence

Judges 6:36-40 (Personal Study Read) — Gideon asks God for more proof using a wool fleece because he is still afraid - twice...God encourages him and still uses him

* This passage seems like an indicator that it's ok to let God know we need help with our faith and that it's not a sin...we are works in progress



There was clearly some dysfunction in both of these men which leads to some tea available to spill In our own dysfunction we pour tea on ourselves. What does that mean?

We have negative self-talk, we put ourselves down for both our past and present sins and give ourselves a sentence of self condemnation

Yes, God wants us to acknowledge our problem areas and shortcomings but He also wants us to bring them to Him so that He can change us and give us a testimony (Tea to Testimony)
