Athlete Agreement

Arizona Tritons athletes lead with integrity, honesty, and a positive mindset. They embrace curiosity, lifelong learning, and a strong work ethic, striving for self-improvement while supporting their teammates and giving their personal best both in the pool and throughout life.

As an athlete member of the Arizona Swimming, Inc. ("AZSI") I understand and will comply with the USA Swimming Code of Conduct as outlined in the USA Swimming Rule Book and the U.S. SafeSport Code available on the websites linked above.

The purpose of a Code of Conduct for athletes is to establish a consistent expectation for athletes' behavior. By signing this code of conduct, I agree to the following statements:

- I will maintain a positive attitude and focus on positive outcomes, avoiding the pitfalls of complaining and negativity at all times.
- I will respect and show courtesy to my teammates and coaches at all times, on deck, and off, including on social media.
- I will be respectful of my teammates' feelings and personal space. Swimmers who exhibit sexist, racist, homophobic, or otherwise inappropriate behavior will be faced with consequences.
- I will demonstrate good sportsmanship at all practices and meets.
- I will set a good example of behavior and work ethic for my younger teammates.
- I will attend all team meetings and training sessions, unless I am excused by my coach.
- I will show respect for all facilities and other property (including locker rooms) used during practices, competitions, and team activities.
- I will refrain from foul language, violence, behavior deemed dishonest, offensive, or illegal.
- If I disagree with an official's call, I will talk with my coach and not approach the official directly.
- I will obey all of USA Swimming's rules and codes of conduct as outlined in the current USA Swimming Rule book. Failure to Comply with Code of Conduct or failure to comply with terms and conditions of the Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action. Such disciplinary action will be recommended by the direct Adult Supervisor (Coach, Parent Chaperone or Official) and determined by Head Coach and Board Leadership.
