Courses to sail descriptions for Saturday and Sunday

Albemarle Spring Challenge Course Description

- 1. Albemarle Plantation to Elizabeth City, Saturday, April 26
  - a. Start approximately <1 nm south of the Yeopim River entrance, leaving all of the following marks to port; 2AS, Harvey Point Warning Lights G, F, E, D, Perquimans R Entrance 2P, Pasquotank R Slue Light 1G, WR 3, PR G5, PR light G 5A, PR G7and finishing east of R8 daybeacon, south of the Old Pelican Marina. The course is about 33 miles.
- 2. Elizabeth City to Albemarle Plantation, Sunday, April 27
  - a. Start east of R8 daybeacon, south of the Old Pelican Marina, leaving all of the following marks to starboard; PR G7, PR light G 5A, PR G5, WR 3, Pasquotank R Slue LIght 1G, Perquimans R Entrance 2P, Harvey Point Warning Lights G, F, E, D, 2AS and finish approximately <1 nm south of the Yeopim River entrance.
- 3. There will be a committee boat anchored and a start/finish pin set for each start and finish. Skippers are responsible for proper navigation and seamanship. Check your charts and avoid shallow shoal areas. Red X indicates government marks, Red Diamond marks shallow area. The bombing range is clearly marked and is out of bounds.
- 2. RC will shorten race if conditions become unsafe, or the wind dies
