It's about our village, building the relationships to support our community of compassion, love and faith. No one of us can do it alone. As I endeavor in my mission to raise awareness and educate about trauma and provide activities that support the adversities in our lives, I often ask myself "where was Skye's village?" That is the impetus of our grant, It Takes a Village, to work together to reach and equip as many people as possible (the world!) with the knowledge to help others in a compassionate, trauma informed way while also making it accessible and affordable for ALL. Each of you have helped to make this happen. Because of your support with Skye's the Limit Foundation we have made great strides towards building a Village of Compassionate Healers of Life. Thank you.

Accomplishments for FY 2021 of It Takes a Village program in partnership between Skye's the Limit Foundation and Neighborhood Ministries, through the Trauma Informed Substance Abuse Primary Prevention grant under the Arizona Governor's Office of Youth, Faith and Family:

Each program partner offered prevention courses and services through Educational, Alternative and Informational methods that were well received and of great interest to the community.

Our Programming Village:

1) Kaity's Way and Sueños Youth Center provided teen dating violence/abusive relationship prevention courses and presentations. We have reached **51 participants**.

2) Arizona Trauma Institute provided trauma education designed in part to prevent re-traumatization. These educational courses included Certified Trauma Support certifications, "Understanding the Dragon", and "Addiction & Trauma". They also provided the Certified Trauma Organization in-depth, life-long training process in which Neighborhood Ministries is currently undergoing. All together we have supported the training of **323 unique participants**.

3) AZ ACEs Consortium aims to prevent toxic stress and trauma by offering ACEs Train the Trainer certifications. We have supported the training **32 participants** with the tools to garner an **exponential reach beyond 32**.

4) AZ Recovers offered their drug abuse prevention education through the "Too Good For Drugs" and "Trauma-Informed Care for Teens" classes. Between the two trainings we have reached and impacted **144 unique youth participants** who have learned about trauma informed care, substance abuse and recognizing when to seek for help and the importance of providing peer support.

5) Skye's the Limit Foundation provided alternative activities through art, kayaking, group and mindfulness engagements as well as information dissemination activities. The alternative activities provided a safe space for dialogue, growth, and peer / relational support. In partnership with the **Sueños Youth Center of Neighborhood Ministries**, we have engaged a

total of **1033 youth and young adult participants** through the various activities, trainings and information dissemination activities.

6) **We continue to nurture our partnerships and relationships while building new ones – our village.**

It truly takes a Village! Thank you for this great opportunity. I am looking forward to strengthening our partnership and endeavors with Neighborhood Ministries for FY 22 of It Takes a Village.
