

What is NIOBY?

NIOBY is a charitable organization made up of individuals that live or work in Eureka. It was formed in 2014. We are a Missouri Non-Profit Corporation and have secured exempt status under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

What does NIOBY do?

NIOBY serves those in our Eureka community who are, for whatever reason, experiencing hardship. We help people who have trouble keeping up with the expense of day-to-day necessities. Essentials like food, clothing, shelter, medical equipment, and infant care supplies, to name a few. We also facilitate assistance for individuals in need through other local organizations that may have the resources that we do not. Organizations such as food pantries, housing authority, utility assistance programs, career development, legal aid, etc.

Who does NIOBY help?

NIOBY helps those that live, work, or learn in the 63025 zip code. We partner with neighborhood food pantries, churches, the Rockwood School District, skilled nursing centers, and backpack programs to identify individuals or families in need. We also have an application on our website that can be filled out directly. Additionally, we have a network of over 300 supporters that have joined our mailing list that we can turn to when special situations arise.
