

HOUSE RULES

* Officers, Directors, Club Manager, and Bartenders, are hereinafter referred to as
"Authorized Personnel".

1. Any Authorized Personnel shall have the right to demand that any member of the club who appears to be causing a nuisance in the club quarters must leave the building and can only re-enter the club at a later date following an appearance before the house committee.
2. Members are permitted to bring their spouse or significant other (boy or girlfriend) and another guest couple in the club. Minors must have proper legal supervision. All will be known as non-members. All non-members must register in the guest book. Guests are permitted only three visits in the club in one calendar year, unless special permission by any Authorized Personnel is given. Qualifying non-member(s) will be asked to become a member and given a membership application. Members are responsible for the conduct of non-members while on the premises, and non-members must leave with the member who sponsored them. Non-members whose application for membership was previously rejected by the Board of Directors may not be brought into the club as guests.
3. Non-members are not permitted to purchase any alcoholic beverages.
4. Members must immediately respond to telephone calls or door calls.
5. No members except Authorized Personnel shall allow an unaccompanied non-member to enter the club. Only the Authorized Personnel shall answer the door calls.
6. Spitting on the floors or other unhealthy habits detrimental to the public health, and mutilation of the club property will not be tolerated. Any member guilty of these actions will have their case heard by the Board of Directors for possible suspension, and restitution will be required before being reinstated as a member.
7. Any member suspended for any length of time who fails to accept official notice will have their membership revoked, and future membership will require submission of a new application for membership.

8. The bartender on duty or the Club Manager has the right to refuse the sale of alcoholic beverages to any member who in their opinion is visible intoxicated or disorderly. Any member who purchases a drink for a member who has been refused service will be subject to disciplinary action by the Board of Directors.
9. No credit will be extended out of the club treasury to any member. Personal checks will be cashed only on the direct authority of the Club Manager. Payroll checks will not be honored. Any person submitting a check which the bank refused to honor for any reason is suspended immediately. If the check is turned over to the District Magistrate for collections, that member is suspended permanently until such time as the executive committee acts to re-instate that member.
10. Members must have their membership card and valid I.D. in their possession while in the club and must present the card upon request at any time.
11. It shall be the responsibility of every member to conduct themselves while in and about the club (including parking lot) in a respectable and orderly manner. It shall be the duty of the Authorized Personnel to eject from the club any member who violates the rule. There shall be no arguments or agitation, but the member has the right to appear at a Board of Directors meeting if they feel aggrieved.
12. No minors are permitted into the club unless accompanied by a parent, legal guardian, or proper supervision (age 25 years or older) and the member shall be responsible to insure that minors do not inconvenience other members. Any minors under the age of 21 are not permitted to sit at the bar. Minors are permitted in the bar area until 9PM and the dining room until 11 PM.
13. If a member is suspended from the club for violation of club rules and that member is also an employee of the club, the employee will be permitted to work, but must leave after the completion of their shift.
14. Club opening hours shall be Sunday, 8 a.m., Monday thru Thursday, 3 p.m., Friday at 11 a.m., and Saturday at 8 a.m. The club hours may be changed from time to time by the Board of Directors.
15. In any case not covered by the above rules, Authorized Personnel shall have the power to make temporary rules as may be necessary for the welfare of the club, subject to the approval of the Board of Directors at its forthcoming meeting.
16. Profanity is prohibited in any form.
17. All rules and regulations established by the Liquor Control Board will be enforced.
18. All persons must dress presentable in the club quarters. Shoes must be worn while in the club. Hats, bandanas and dew rags are permitted as long as they are not vulgar.

19. All people shall treat the hired personnel with respect: and the hired personnel must treat all customers with respect. Any violation will be reported to the Board of Directors, from either side.
20. For the safety and respect to all members and guests, we ask that no weapons be brought in the club. All weapons are prohibited.
21. Shots must be consumed at the bar, limited number of shots at the bartender's discretion. Any drink containing more than four liquors are limited to two drinks per person.
22. Effective June 21st, 2023 the club became tobacco free. (This includes all vaping and tobacco products indoors.)
23. Smoking and Vaping to be done in designated area outside only for employees and patrons.
