Fifth Sunday of Pascha - The Samaritan Woman (St. Photina)

It was around noon one day when Jesus' followers stopped on the way to Galilee in Samaria to buy food, leaving Him to rest at the well outside the city called "Jacob's well", frequented by locals and visitors. It was there he encountered a Samaritan woman approaching the well with her water jar to draw water, when the Lord Jesus interrupted her, saying, "Give me a drink." This struck the woman as odd, and she remarked, "You are a Jew, and I am a Samaritan woman. How can you ask me for a drink?" For Jews did not associate with Samarians, not alone female ones.

Jesus answered, "If you recognized the gift of God and who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked him for a drink, and he would have given you living water." In response, "Sir," she teased, "you have nothing to draw with, and the well is deep. Where can you get this *living* water? Are you greater than our father Jacob who provided this well?"

"Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again," Jesus replied. "But whoever drinks of the water I give him will never thirst. For the water I give will become a spring of water, welling up to eternal life." In jest she replied, "Give me some of this water, that I mightn't get thirsty and have to keep coming to this well." Jesus rebuked, "Go call your husband and come back." And she countered, "I have no husband." Jesus responded, "Indeed you are right to say you have no husband; for you've had five husbands, and the one you're living with now you aren't married to."

"Sir, I can see you are a prophet. Our fathers worshiped on this mountain, but you Jews claim the place for worship is Jerusalem." Jesus answered, "Believe me, woman, a time is coming when you will worship the Father neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem, for God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in spirit." To this she said, "I know that the Messiah is coming. When he comes he will explain everything to us. That is when Jesus told her, "I who speak to you am he."

Hearing this, the woman hurried off, abandoning her water jar, heading back into town, telling everybody, "Come and see a man who told me everything I ever did! Could this be the Christ?" On account of the Samaritan woman's testimony many Samaritans came out of town that day to approach Jesus, and having heard for themselves, they knew truly that this man was the savior of the world.
