Sunday of All Saints of Ukraine:

On this day we not only commemorate those saints who are well known, but also those whose names we don't know, who are not officially recognized by the church but nonetheless attained the kingdom of heaven by the grace of God and are essentially saints. All the saints of Ukraine remembered today followed the example of Jesus Christ. All of them fulfilled God's commandment of love of God and their fellow human beings.

Nowhere on earth is there a place that has produced more saints than the Kiev Caves Monastery. In addition to the 123 incorruptible remains of saints who lived their saintly lives inside the monastery walls, there are also 61 myrrh-bearing skulls of unknown saints preserved there with the Fathers of the Caves.

For many, times were difficult in Ukraine, maybe more difficult than ours here in the United States. Often their situations in life were more dangerous in spiritual terms and worse in worldly terms. But they still continued, struggled, and reached their reward in paradise where they now triumph. Even we can strive to become saints also.

Saints are not born, they are made. We are all born to potentially become saints. The only difference between ourselves who are not saints, and the saints is that they are people who are continually picking themselves up after sinning, not giving up, continually repenting until they reach holiness. ~ *Orthodox Church in America - www.oca.org*
