Saints Peter & Paul:

Saint Peter was the follower of Jesus Christ who, in answer to His question of who He was, replied, "Thou art the Christ, the son of the living god." In answer to this the Savior deemed worthy the reply, "Blessed art thou, Simon; I tell thee, thou art Peter (Petrus), and on this stone (petra) I build my church." (Mt. 16:16-18)

In his final days of his earthly life the Lord entrusted the apostle Peter to shepherd His spiritual flock, because Peter was first among the Apostles and as such the representative of the Church. After His resurrection He said to him, "I give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on the earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on the earth will be loosed in heaven." (Mt. 16:19)

True to his calling, the Apostle Peter gave his soul to Christ's flock, suffering a martyr's death, now glorified throughout the world.

The Apostle Paul, formerly Saul, was an enemy to the Church, authorized by the high priests to throw all Christians in chains for execution. When he came to Damascus the Lord called out to him from heaven, "Saul, Saul, why do you persecute Me?" Trembling and frightened Saul asks, "Who are you, Lord?" and the Lord replies, "I am Jesus, whom you persecute." Astonished, Saul beacons, "What would You have me to do?" And the voice replies, "Arise and go into the city, and it shall be told what thou must do" (Acts 9:6). Here the Lord sends Ananias. "Go down the street to a man named Saul and baptize him, for he is My chosen instrument to proclaim My name before pagans and rulers and people of Israel." (Acts 9:11-18)

After this Paul transforms his pride into humility: "I am the least of the Apostles, but I worked harder than all of them, yet not I, but the grace of God that was with me." (1 Cor. 15:9-10)
