Dormition of Theotokos: After the Ascension of the Lord, the Mother of God remained in the care of the apostle John. On one of her routine visits to Golgotha to visit the Sepulcher of the Lord, the archangel Gabriel appeared to her handing her a palm branch, announcing her approaching departure from this life to eternal life. With these heavenly tidings the Mother of God returned to Bethlehem along with her attendants.

Then the Holy Spirit intervened, transporting all the apostles and disciples to Bethlehem, for varying reasons, to partake of the blessing and burial of the Mother of God. Upon arrival, with John announcing the time was at hand of the virgin's repose, the Holy Mother of God blessed them for their faith and the hardships they endured while preaching the gospel, and to wish them eternal bliss.

At the third hour while she was praying for the arrival of her longed-for Son and Lord, He suddenly descending from heaven, surrounded by hosts of angels, archangels, and souls of forefathers and prophets who had prophesied the virgin Mary. Seeing her Son, she extolled, "My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my savior, for He hath regarded the low estate of his handmaiden." And rising from her bed to meet the Lord, she gave up her soul into the hands of her Son and her God. The angels broke into song as the heavenly gates opened, and cherubim and seraphim glorified the soul of the most holy Mother of God.

John, Peter, Paul, James, and all the other apostles, except Thomas, carried the funeral bier in a solemn procession to the garden of Gethsemane, accompanied by a multitude of the faithful, carrying candles and censers and singing sacred songs, placed the bier in the tomb, and sealed the entrance to the cave with a large stone. For three days they remained at the tomb, praying and chanting psalms. When Thomas finally arrived he laid down at the tomb with bitter tears asking that he might look once more upon the Mother of God and bid her farewell. When the apostles opened the grave they found only grave wrappings, thus convinced of the bodily ascent of the virgin Mary to heaven.

That evening when the apostles gathered at a nearby house for repast, the Mother of God appeared to them, saying, "Rejoice! I am with you all the days of your lives."
