## High Martyr Agathonikes (Sept. 4):

The Martyrs Agathonikes, Zotikos, Theoprepios, Akyndinos, Severian, Zinon and others accepted death for Christ during the reign of Emperor Maximian (284-305).

The Martyr Agathonikes was descended from the illustrious lineage of the Hypasians, and he lived at Nicomedia. Having become well versed in holy scripture, he converted many pagans to Christ, along with the Princeps of the Senate.

Comitus Evtolmius was sent to the Lower Black Sea region, where he crucified the followers of the Christian Zotikos, all who had refused to offer sacrifice to idols. But Zotikos himself he took with him.

In Nicomedia, Evtolmius arrested the Martyr Agathonikes, together with the Princeps of the Senate, and also Theoprepios, Akyndinos and Severian. After tortures, Evtolmius ordered that the martyrs be taken to Thrace for trial by the emperor. But along the way, in the vicinity of Potama, he put to death the Martyrs Zotikos, Theoprepios and Akyndinos, who were unable to proceed further behind the chariot of the governor because of wounds received during torture. The Martyr Severian was put to death at Chalcedon, and the Martyr Agathonikes, together with others, was beheaded by sword under orders of the emperor in Selymbria.

The relics of the Martyr Agathonikes were seen at a church named for him in Constantinople in the year 1200 by the Russian pilgrim Antonii. And in the 1300's, Philotheos, Archbishop of Selymbria, devoted a discourse of laudation to the Martyr Agathonikes
