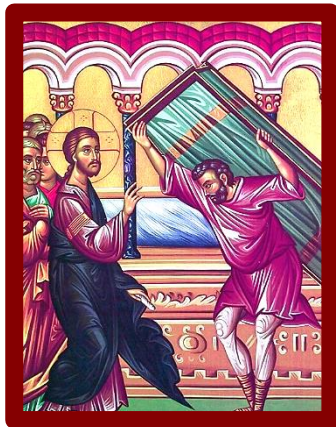

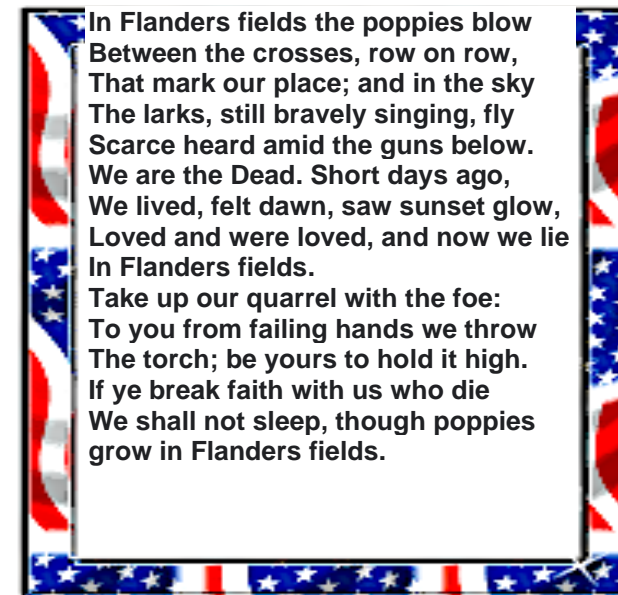
SUNDAY OF THE PARALYTIC
