

We are also assured of God's mercy and compassion by Christ's words to Zacchaeus, "Today salvation has come to this house" (Luke 19:9). Zacchaeus was short of stature, so he climbed a tree to see the Lord. We are also short in our spiritual stature; therefore, we must climb the ladder of the virtues. We must now prepare for spiritual effort and growth.
