Unless there is a medical condition that requires you to have food or drink with you, we ask that you please refrain from bringing food or drink into the sanctuary. Thank you

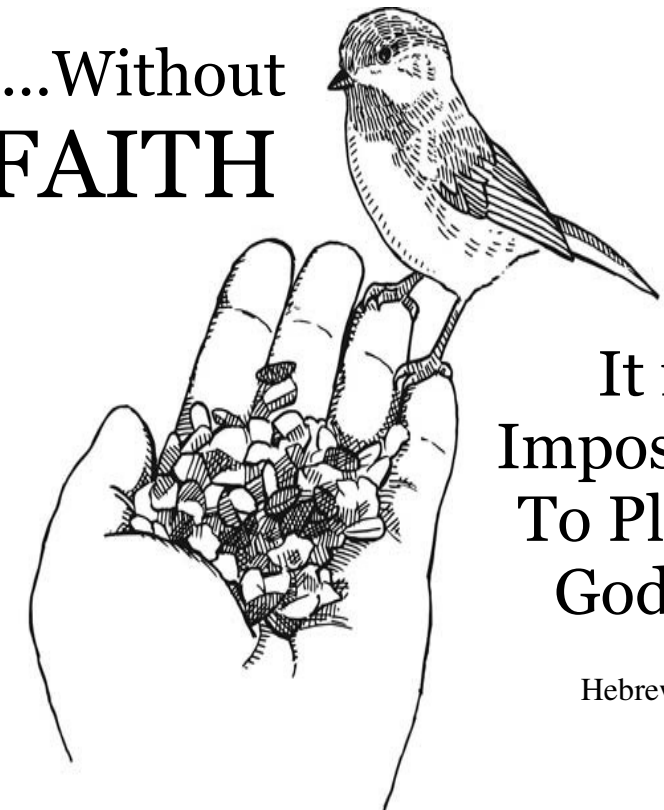
