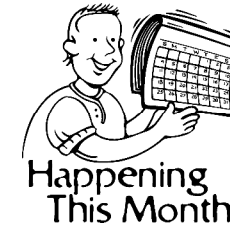

**Altar Flowers**

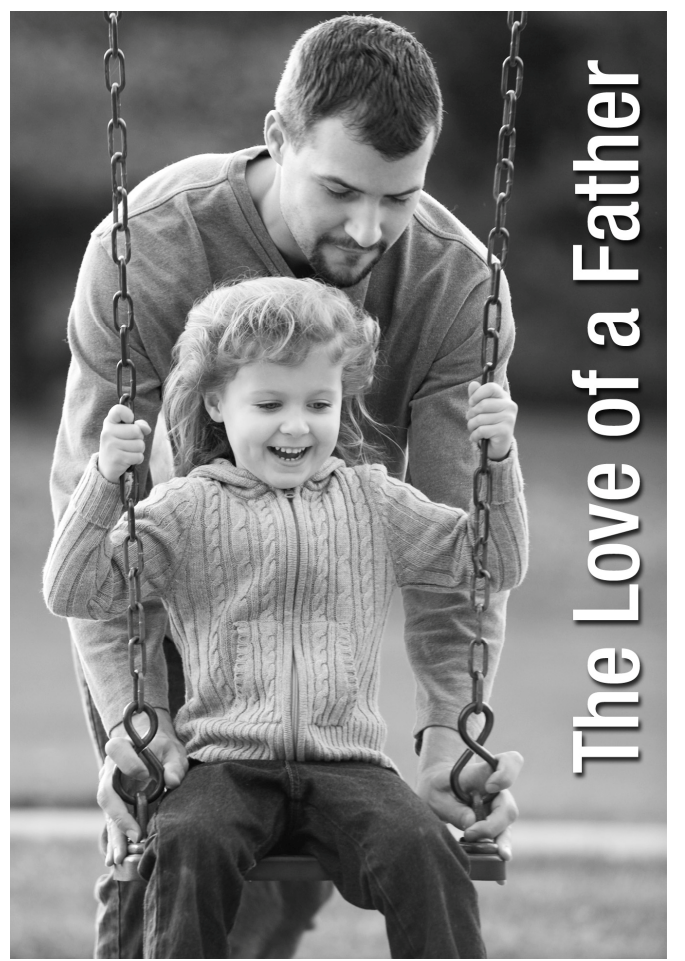
Aren't the pulpit flowers beautiful? You can have a part in this beautiful ministry by placing an arrangement on the altar in honor or in memory of someone!
