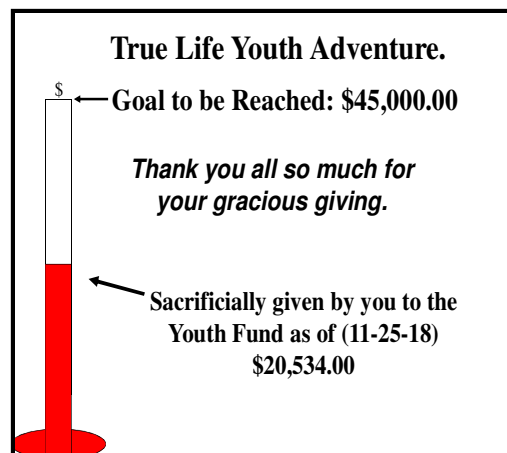

We will have a quarterly business meeting December 16, directly after the evening service. The agenda for the meeting will be available next Sunday on the foyer table.




Youth Winter Retreat

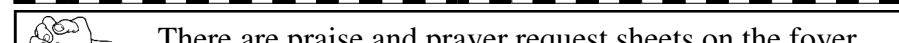
LADIES INVITED TO WOMEN AT THE WELL!!
