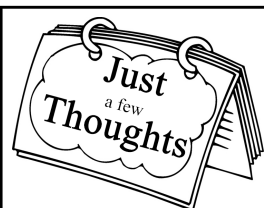

 year. Thank you

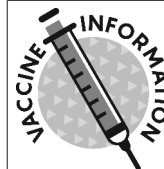


Aren't the pulpit flowers beautiful?

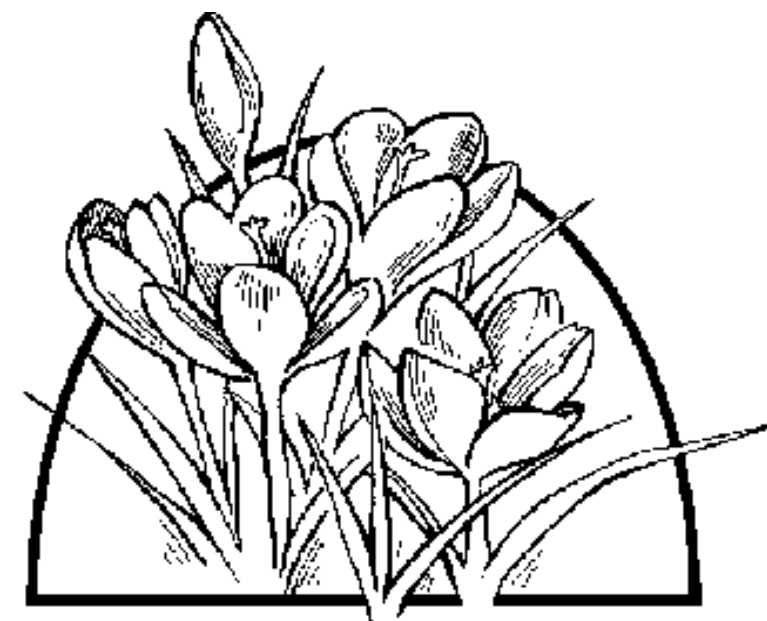
- *There are men's and women's restrooms immediately through the door
