Cancellation Information

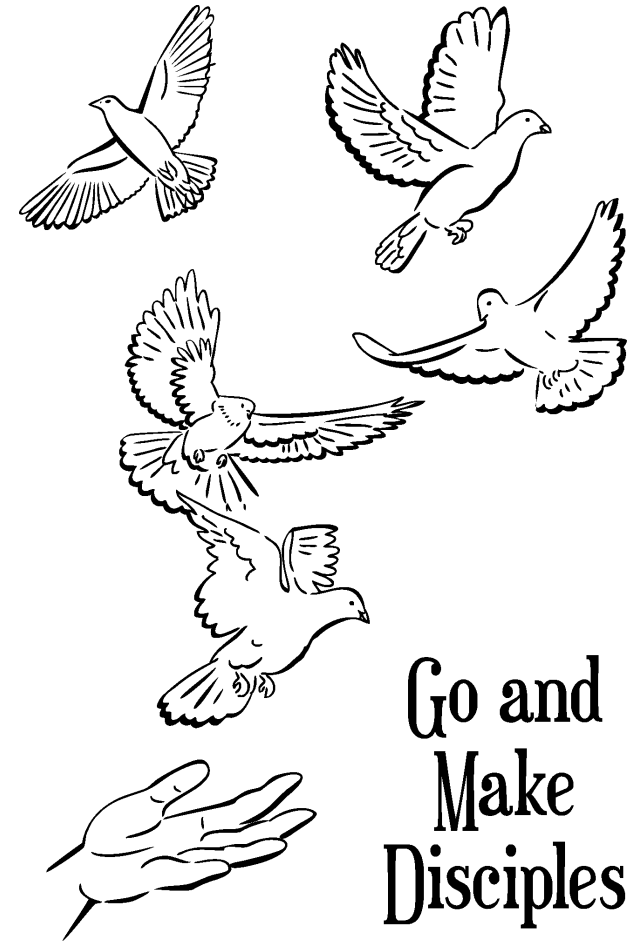
