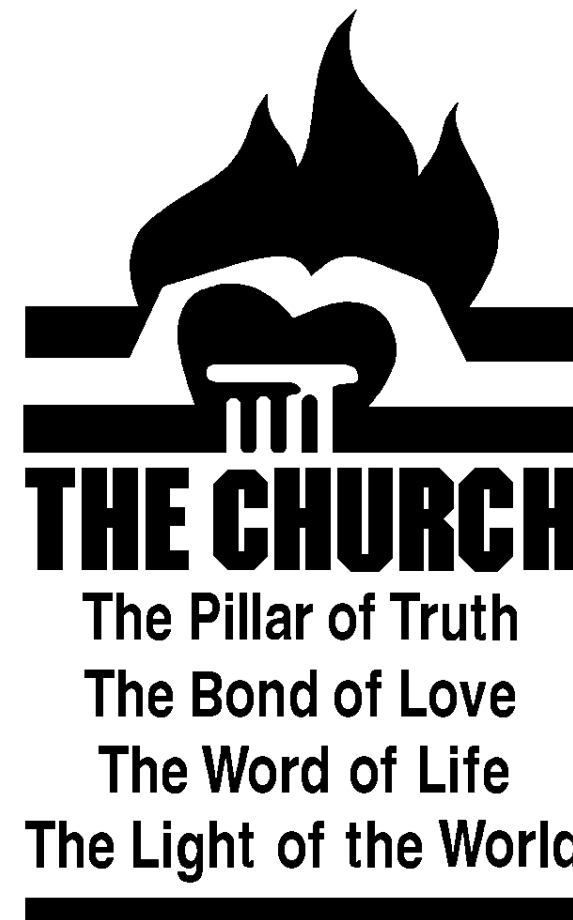
**Cancellation Information**
