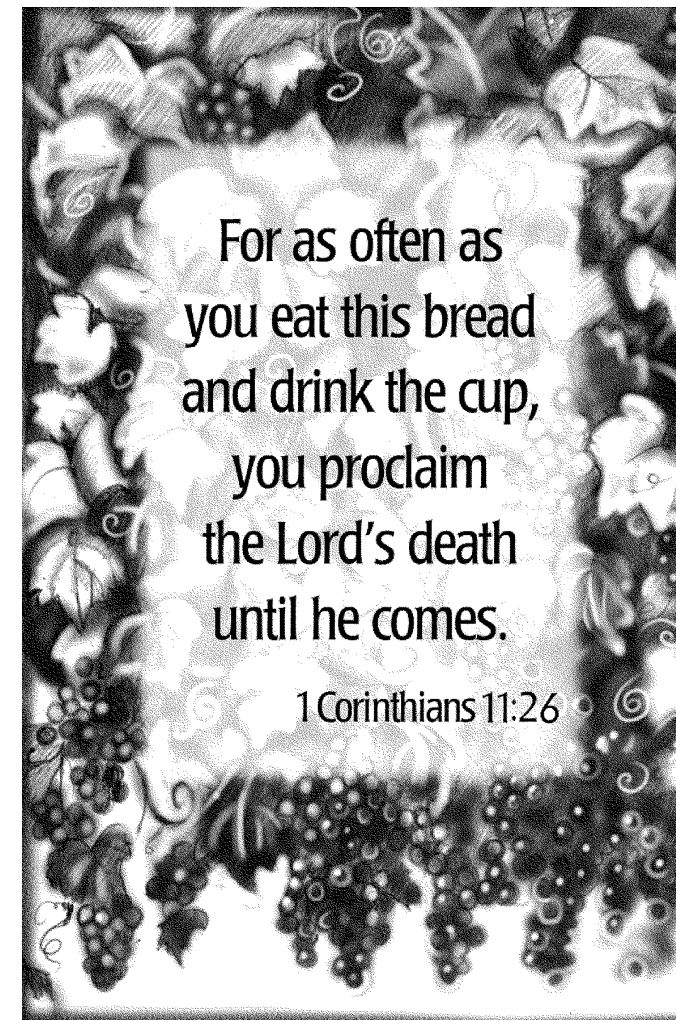
The altar arrangement today is in memory of my daughter, Noelle Thornton, 12/14/93-4/4/18.
