Some helpful information might be:

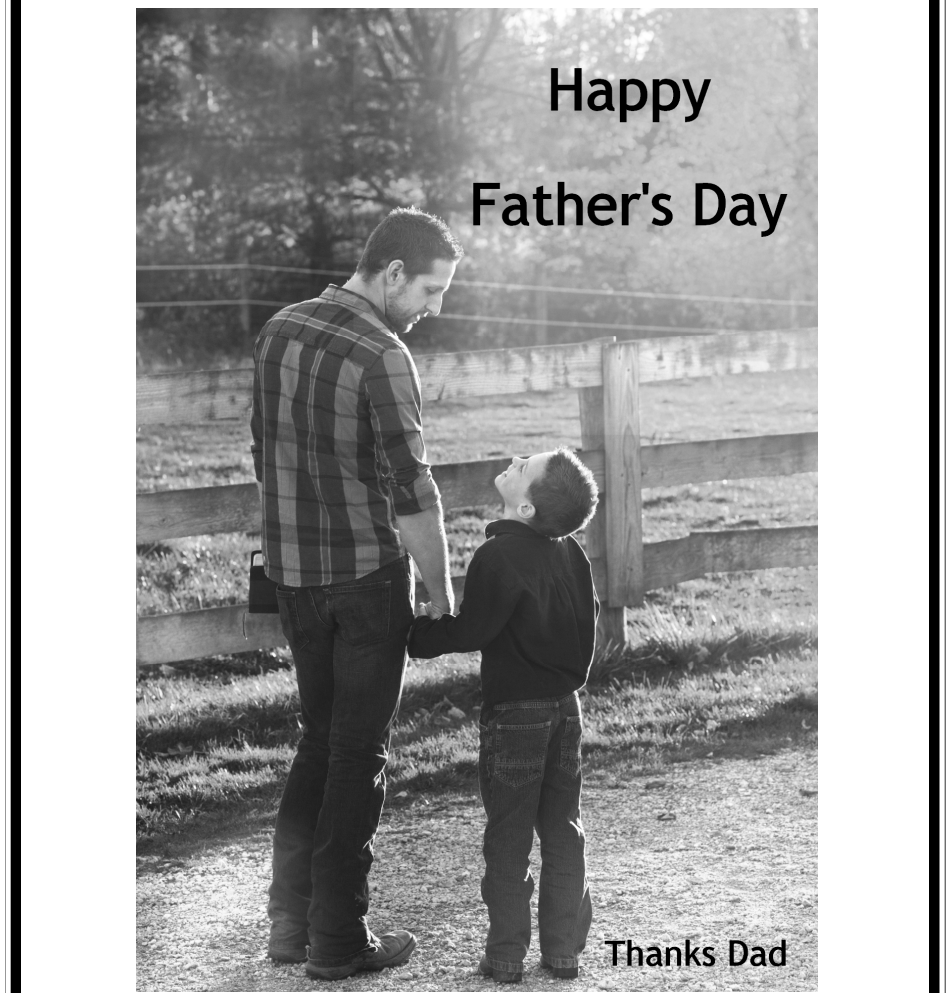
- *There are men's and women's restrooms immediately through the door on either side of the front of the auditorium.
