Our food pantry served a total of 122 families last month!! That was 348 people in our community who were able to receive healthy food!!

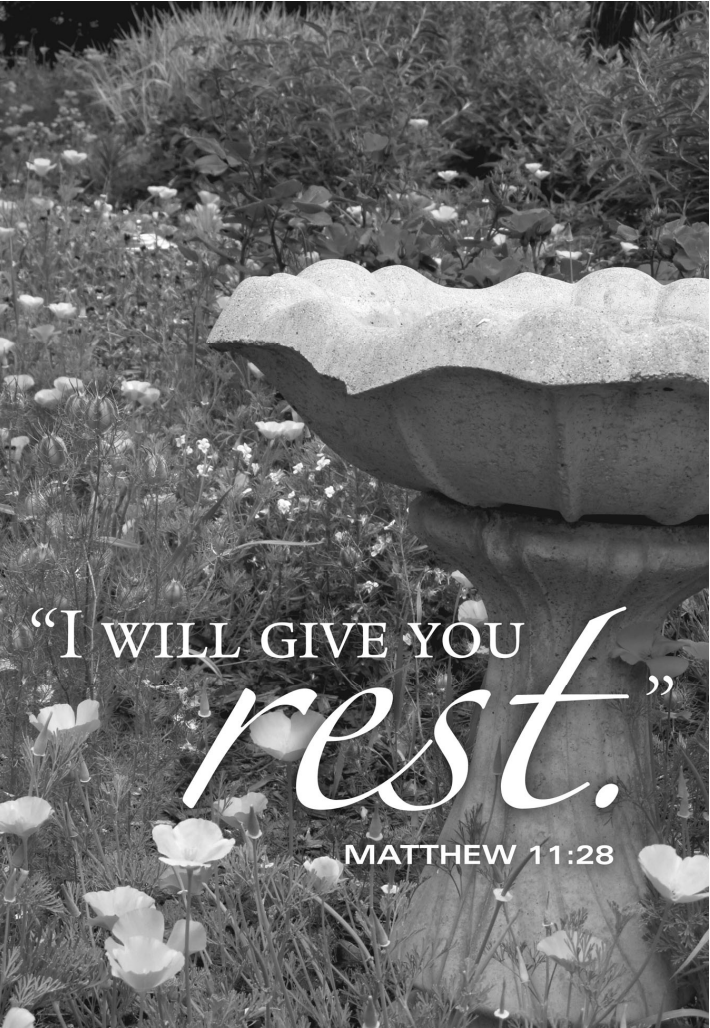
