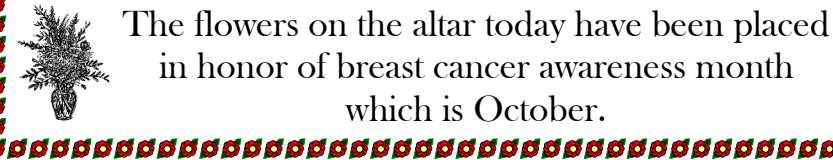

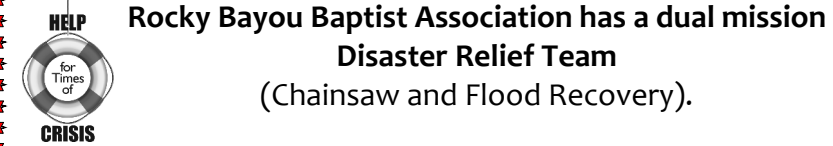

The flowers on the altar today have been placed in honor of breast cancer awareness month which is October.



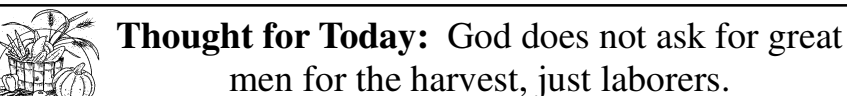
Rocky Bayou Baptist Association has a dual mission Disaster Relief Team (Chainsaw and Flood Recovery).
