
 **OLD LITERATURE IS STILL USEFUL!!**

 **Kitchen & FLC Guidelines**



WORLD MISSIONS GIVING

On the regular offering envelopes mailed to your home is a place to give to world missions. When you give to that offering the disbursement is set up as follows: Lottie Moon 40%, Dixie Jackson 20%, Annie Armstrong 20%, & our church missions/mission projects 20%. We will still have our regular missions emphases throughout the year and you can mark your envelope for a particular missions offering any time. Any other giving to world missions will be disbursed as stated above. This creates an opportunity to give to missions all year!

- Assist the family in understanding the agency's concerns in relation to safety and risk.
- Fully participate in a meeting and share ideas for ensuring children's safety while supporting the family.

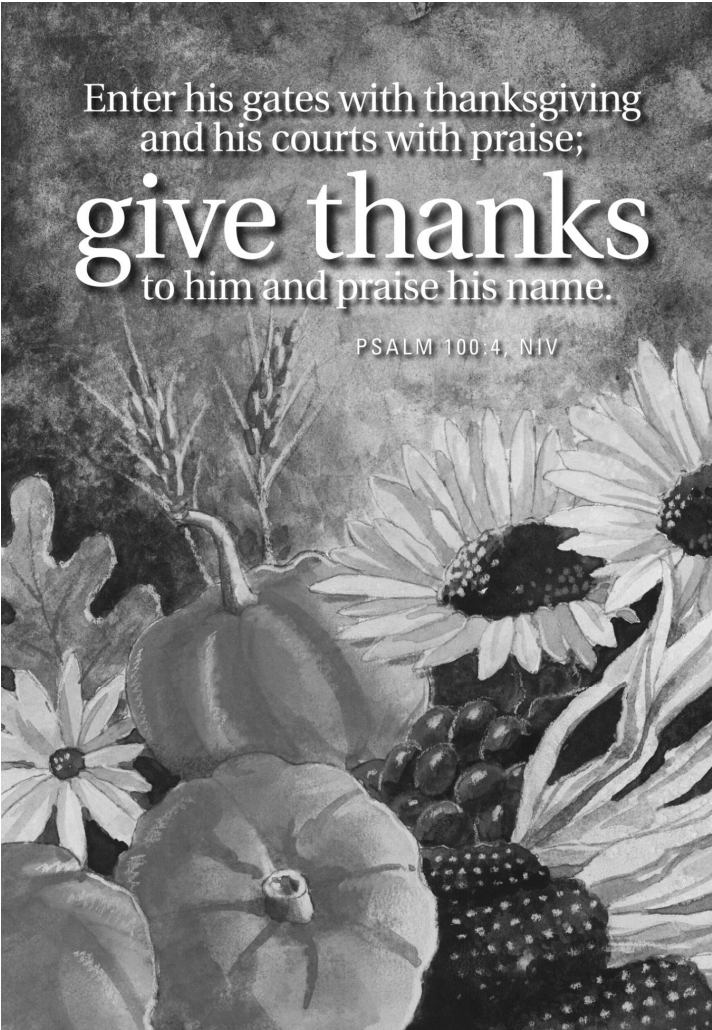
