

Dixie Jackson AR State Missions Offering Begins next Sunday, September 14

What is it? In 1914, a woman named Dixie Jackson accepted a full-time role with the AR Woman's Missionary Union (WMU). She traveled across the state, training women and championing the cause of missions in AR. Her passion for reaching the lost and equipping believers led her to help establish a Week of Prayer for AR Missions in 1926. Just three years later, that week included a special offering raising over \$1,000 to fund local missions efforts. By 1935, the offering was officially named in memory of Dixie Jackson, honoring her legacy of faith and commitment to the mission field right here at home. Today, that legacy continues. Every dollar given directly supports mission efforts across our state. From disaster relief and community outreach to missions, discipleship and more, this offering equips AR Baptists to go, serve, and share the hope of Jesus with those who



need Him most.
