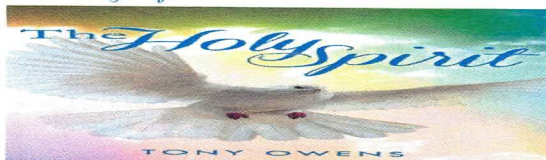

Women's Ministry

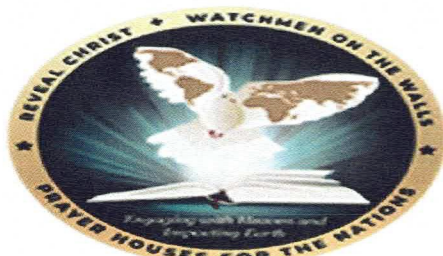
