

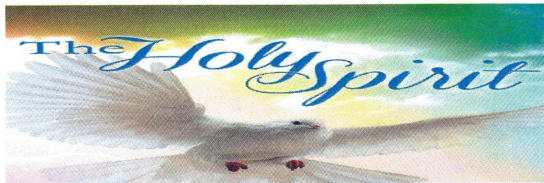

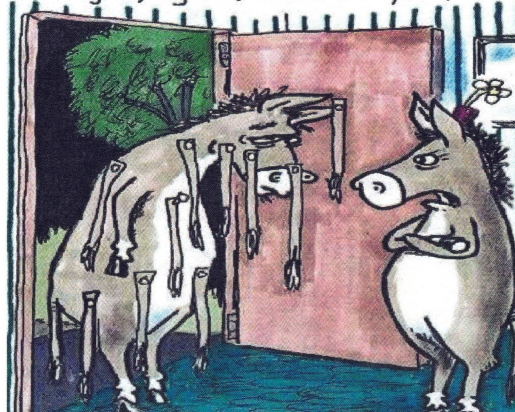
We are almost through the Book of 1st John. Make plans to come join us as we discuss and find truths from the Word of God. Beginning at 6 p.m.

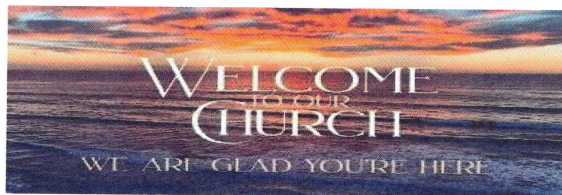
