2 Corinthians 10:5 (AMP) [Inasmuch as we] refute arguments *and* theories *and* reasonings and every proud *and* lofty thing that sets itself up against the [true] knowledge of God; and we lead every thought *and* purpose away captive into the obedience of Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One).

Anxiety thrives when we focus on the future- when we let ourselves become consumed with the {what-ifs and worst-case scenarios}

Luke 12:25-26 (AMP) And which of you by being overly anxious *and* troubled with cares can add a cubit to his stature *or* a moment [unit] of time to his age [the length of his life]? ²⁶ If then you are not able to do such a little thing as that, why are you anxious *and* troubled with cares about the rest?

Breaking the anxiety cycle requires us to shift our focus. We must learn to trust God with tomorrow and focus on what He is asking us to do today! SELAH! (Copied)
