### Logs, Fires & BBQs

We have a supply of kiln dried logs, kindling, firelighters and marshmallows for toasting which you'll find in the Info Shed. If you are using your own logs, please ensure the wood is kiln dried to comply with environmental regulations and to reduce smoke. *Broken pallets and construction timber should not be used as these are treated with chemicals and contain nails.* **Fire pits and BBQs must be placed on the gravel hardstandings and not the grass** or if you are on a camping pitch, please use the fire pit provided and keep all BBQS well clear of the grass. **Please see the firepit guidance before lighting any fires.**

- Strictly no music/radios or instruments to be played at any time. Noise must be kept to a minimum between 10pm and 8am. Vehicle use is discouraged during this time.
- Pitches are available from 1pm and must be vacated by 11am on the day of departure.
- Fences must not be climbed on or used as a washing line. Barbed wire is used in public areas and can cause serious injuries.
- Barbeques and campfires (in suitable fire pits, if not fixed) are permitted, though must be kept well clear of the grass on camping pitches or placed on gravel hard standings if you're in a touring pitch.
