### **Summer Work Camp Announces 2023 Plans**

Jam is already developing both the leadership and the schedule for the summer of 2023. The success of this ministry is based upon at least 10 mission teams participating. One new group has already been calendared. JAM's leadership envisions us securing a work camp coordinator in addition to a local contact person, along with a group leader from each work team. This system should provide a quality of direction not seen in recent years.



As a reminder, to make this happen and to combat rising raw material costs,

JAM has been forced to adjust fees. The application fee is to be increased to \$700 and the materials fee will see an increase to \$125. These increases reflect both the new leadership and inflation impact on costs.

JAM work camping has made a difference in countless lives and we pray that the future years will do the same.

JAM would like to give a "shout out" and Special Thank you to board member Gary Stabler and his wife, Sharon. They have spent several hours spread across several days single handedly cleaning, organizing and straightening the storage facilities here at Jackson Area Ministries.
