INTRODUCTION: Judas – Matthias

The Webster dictionary defines a mystery as "something not understood or beyond understanding: enigma". For the Church, a mystery is something that we can understand gradually, but the total understanding is after death. A mystery can be a person, a thing, an affair, a situation, etc. Judas, the Apostle was a mystery. Even more so, his choice by Jesus was even a greater mystery. The All-knowing God chose someone who will betray Him.

In today's First Reading, the Seventh Sunday of Easter, we have the election of Matthias, to succeed Judas. The Apostles, waiting for the Coming of the Holy Spirit, and knowing that the Master chose 12, wanted to respect this number, so they prayed and elected Matthias to take the place of Judas. This is the beginning of the apostolic succession in the Church, that means the choosing or election of Bishops. The lot they made fell on Matthias (Feast Day: May 14). The book of Leviticus chapter 16,8 tells the story how the choice is made. According to some Fathers of the Church, like Saint Clement of Alexandria, Matthias is identified as Zaccheus of the gospel.
