Saint Mark in today's gospel answers a crucial question. When people look at the reality of their daily life (suffering, stress, anxiety,....) and the way things are in the world (evil in the world; the strong get stronger; the rich get richer while the poor get poorer; leaders at all levels work only for their benefit and the benefit of their families, etc....), a question comes immediately to mind: why keep the faith? Or why believe in the Gospel? Or "where is God in the world?" We often hear this last question from those who don't believe in God. St Mark answers with the parables of the seed, which for him means Trust in God and Patience, while accepting the daily reality. God acts and continues to do so in a world that doesn't listen. We cannot doubt that the gospel itself was a seed that has grown up and reached us today. Only Trust in God and Patience can help us to see,
