THE FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

"Then Jesus said (to the woman) 'Neither do I condemn you. Go and from now on do not sin anymore'." While Jesus is teaching in the presence of His disciples and of a crowd, they threw in front of Him this woman caught in adultery. It is not a woman that they presented to Jesus it is a dossier. The woman is only an alibi. She has no say. Both, Jesus and the woman will be condemned: The woman for committing adultery, and Jesus for violating the law of Moses if He frees her. What a picture! Misery facing Mercy. The woman in and with her shame, and Jesus in His Power to forgive. Strangely, the accusers become their own judges in condemning themselves by running away, thus freeing their victims. Jesus's silence here is greater than words. Please, let's be clear, Jesus is not ignoring sins. His position is even or rather harder than the one of the accusers. Jesus sees in the accusers the same sin as the one on the accused. He is sending everyone to the source, our conscience. Everyone has only one thing to do: shut up. This silence invites all of us: "Go and sin no more".
