

THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

Today's gospel reads: "Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw His star at it rising and have come to do Him homage".

Today's Feast and today's gospel are among the most popular in the Christian world. Yes, the story of the Magi that we (wrongly so) sometimes called 3 Kings. From the get go, let's ask ourselves: What is our star today? Sometimes, our star is an event in our life, an encounter, a joy (like the birth of a child) or a sad situation (the loss of a loved one). Each of these situations that we mentioned (there could be many others) could light up and become a star in our lives. Because of that, we must raise our heads, stand up, and abandon all our "knowledge/certainties" of the past. Our life is shaken. Someone or something has happened. We don't yet understand, but if we act like the Magi, we will certainly have an answer. The most important gifts from the Magi to Jesus is the pilgrimage that they have made; it's the trust in the star; it's the certainty that they have which is that they lack something in their lives, no matter how wealthy they are. They understand that God is not in their lives and they have to look for Him. The star is still shining today. What is missing is that most of the people don't follow their star. The Magi, who represent each human being, show us the way to The "God from God, Light from Light, True God from True God, Begotten, not made, Consubstantial with The Father". Remember: The wise still look for Him.
