Jesus addressed a great crowd: "If anyone comes to me without hating his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, and even his own life, he cannot be my disciple. Whoever does not carry his own cross and come after me cannot be my disciple". Here we go. These words don't allow ANY interpretation nor explanation. They are crystal clear. They are meant for those who want to be in God's kingdom. Unfortunately, these words are misunderstood, and people give them different meanings: some people might be shocked and seeing this as Jesus's relentless demand (that means aloofness or lack of emotional involvement or even indifference or unconcern feeling towards others even one's own parents). On the other hand, other people might just be disappointed and discouraged. In both cases, they are wrong. Jesus just wants us to have priorities if we want eternal life. We are called not to be heroes, but to go beyond oneself, to surpass ourselves, that means to push one's limits. According to Saint Luke, the only obstacle to surpassing oneself is the hardening of our hearts. We cannot follow Jesus by doing what we want, but what He wants.
