THE TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Jesus says in today's gospel: "For behold, some are last who will be first and some are first who will be last". This phrase somewhat "strange" comes as a conclusion to a debate that we hold rather often: "Who will be saved"? Or "How many people will be saved"? Hot issue question. It's a question from people of not only our times, but from people of all times. But it's really not a good question. Notice that Jesus doesn't answer. He takes the opportunity to send each one to his/her attitude. Instead of answering the question (who will be saved?), Jesus instead says: "strive to enter through the narrow gate". That is why He came, to lead us, to show us the path, the way ("I am The Way, The Truth, and The Life"). Those who will enter the kingdom of God that means who will be saved are those who will follow His path. That is what Isaiah is saying in today's First Reading when he writes: "They shall bring all your brothers and sisters from all the nations...".
