## VILLAGE OF HOSSTON MINUTES OF THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING HELD SEPTEMBER 17, 2024

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Village of Hosston met in regular session Tuesday, September 17, 2024, at 6:30 pm, in the Village Hall, Hosston, LA.

Present: Mayor Kim Jaynes, Alderman Misti Banks, Alderman Henry Blunt, Alderman Vicki Carter, and Chief Ramona Anders.

Also Present: Lee Ann Blunt, Bricen Prentice, Emmett Carter, Jimmy Phillips, and Crystal Carnley.

Mayor Jaynes called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm, at which time a quorum was verified. Opening prayer was led by Alderman Banks and all present joined in the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no public comments on agenda items.

Chief Anders reported that she completed another class where she received useful information and resources that would be beneficial. She also reported that she has still been patrolling regularly and had addressed some issues concerning trash in resident's yards.

Mayor Jaynes informed the board that the name of the new walking path and pavilion would be Village of Hosston Memorial Park. She stated that the public will be allowed to purchase a tree in memory of their loved one that will be planted along the walking path, as well as a stone with their loved one's name. The ceremony to recognize the new park will be announced at a later date. Mayor Jaynes announced that a rummage sale will take place on October 12<sup>th</sup> at the pavilion for anyone who had items to donate.

Alderman Blunt made a motion to approve the minutes of the regular session meeting on August 20, 2024, seconded by Alderman Banks. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Carter made a motion to approve the financials for August 2024, seconded by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, motion carried.

Alderman Banks made a motion to adopt **Resolution 8 of 2024**: A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2023 CADDO PARISH MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN, seconded by Alderman Carter. All in favor, motion carried.

A discussion was had concerning the town's savings account. Three options were taken into consideration: place the money into another CD, place the money into a money market account, or invest the money into the LAMP

program. A decision was not finalized.

A quote was presented to the board from Briggs Tyson to build three restriction headers to be put over the culverts at the library. The quote was approved by the board.

Alderman Carter made a motion to adjourn at 7:05pm, seconded by Alderman Blunt. All in favor, motion carried.
